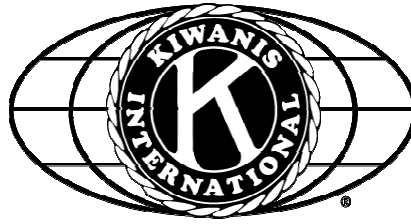


KIWANIS CLUB OF BEREHA
